



# Using "User Progress > Visibility" to check if a course content / test is visible to individual students

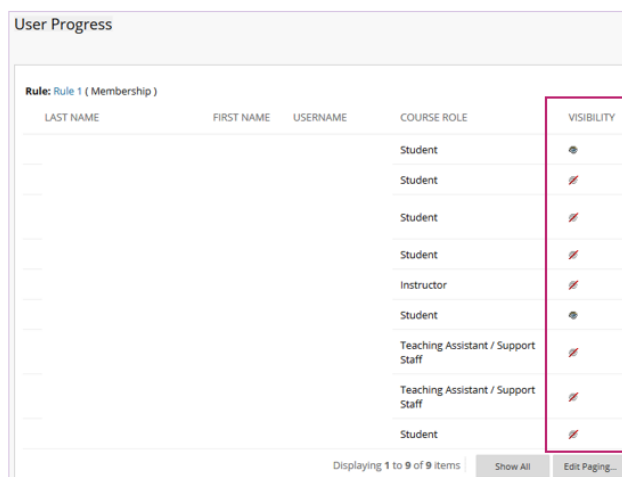
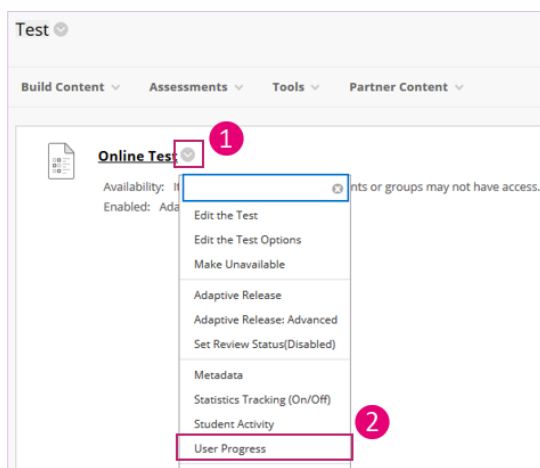
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## Overview









- Applicable to all course menu items, course content items, assignments and tests
- Particular useful for checking adaptive release and test availability exceptions configurations.

## Steps:

1. Access an item's menu.
2. Select "User Progress". Then check "Visibility".
  - An open eye  indicates that the item is visible to the students.
  - A closed eye  indicates that the item is not visible to the students.
